**Sub:- Mandatory e-Publishing of all Tender Enquiries on the Central Public Procurement Portal**

It has been made mandatory for all Central Government Ministries/Departments, their attached and sub-ordinate offices to mandatorily publish all their Tender Enquiries, irrespective of item and its value, issued on or after 01-01-2012, online on Central Public Procurement Portal: <http://eprocure.gov.in>. In this regard, D.O. Letter No. 10/1/2011-PPC Dated 12<sup>th</sup> Dec 2011 from Secretary (Expenditure) to Secretary (Commerce) refers, copy attached for ready reference.

2. Matter has been taken up with concerned authorities, to make provision in the e-Application, so that all Tender Enquiries being published on url: <https://www.dgsndtenders.gov.in> are automatically picked up and published on Central Public Procurement Portal: <http://eprocure.gov.in> also. Notwithstanding above, it shall be the responsibility of the concerned purchase officer to ensure that all of their Tender Enquiries and Corrigendum thereto are getting published on <http://eprocure.gov.in>. However, for Tender Enquiries, which are not presently being published on url: <https://www.dgsndtenders.gov.in>, purchase officer will have to specifically upload the Tender Enquiries and all corrigendum thereto on <http://eprocure.gov.in>.

3. All DGS&D officers, whether posted in Purchase, QA, Administration, in HQ or Regions, who are required to issue Tender Enquiries, may write to C&T Directorate for allotment of user ID/Password clearly indicating the Name of the Officer along with email ID and mobile number, Designation of the Officer, and the Address of the Office. Using aforesaid user ID/passwords, the officers would be able to upload Tender Enquiries/Corrigendum on url: <http://eprocure.gov.in>.

4. Accordingly, all DGS&D Purchase Directorates in HQ and regions, QA Offices and Administration Directorate are requested to kindly note the aforesaid guidelines for strict compliance.

In pursuance of the recommendations of the Committee on Public Procurement headed by Shri Vinod Dhall and the decisions thereon of the Group of Ministers constituted to consider measures to tackle corruption and ensure transparency, the Department of Expenditure has, vide OM dated 30<sup>th</sup> November 2011, issued instructions for setting up a Central Public Procurement Portal (CPP Portal) with an e-publishing (of tender details) module and an e-procurement module. The CPP Portal will be set up by the National Informatics Center (NIC) and will be accessible at the URL [eprocure.gov.in](http://eprocure.gov.in). While e-publishing of tender enquiries, corrigenda thereto and details of contracts awarded thereon, on the CPP Portal, shall be made mandatory in a phased manner w.e.f 1<sup>st</sup> January 2012, the comprehensive end-to-end e-Procurement feature would be implemented in a phased manner w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April 2012.

2. The CPP Portal is expected to be functional from 19<sup>th</sup> December 2011. It will be mandatory for all Ministries/ Departments of the Central Government, Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) and autonomous and statutory bodies to publish all their tender enquiries issued on or after the following dates, on the CPP Portal :

- (Att-1)*
- In the case of Ministries/ Departments and their attached and subordinate offices w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> January 2012;
  - In the case of CPSEs w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> February 2012;
  - In the case of Autonomous/statutory bodies w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2012.

3. In order to facilitate implementation of the project, the following activities are planned :

- A workshop for Nodal Officers of all Ministries/ Departments will be held on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2011 at Department of Expenditure to sensitize them of the features of the CPP Portal and the methodology of operating the Portal.
  - NIC will arrange training programmes for concerned officials in batches with hands-on sessions, starting from 20<sup>th</sup> December 2011.
  - A demo site for practice and training will also be available on the Portal from 19<sup>th</sup> December 2011, which will contain the documents on implementation guidelines, detailed presentation materials, etc.

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- d. From 20<sup>th</sup> December 2011, NIC will start issuing User IDs, Passwords and Digital Certificates for operating the Portal.
  - e. NIC will set up a call centre for clarifying doubts regarding operation of the Portal. In addition, NIC will also keep a core team to clarify doubts and assist in implementation.
4. Necessary action may please be taken to ensure that e-publishing of tender details on the CPP Portal is commenced as per the dates mentioned in para 2 above. Necessary instructions may also be issued in this regard to all attached and subordinate offices as also to CPSEs, autonomous and statutory bodies. In this context, the following action is also requested:
- a. A suitable Nodal Officer (preferably at the Joint Secretary level) may be nominated to coordinate the implementation of the project. The Nodal Officer may be assisted by a Director/DS level officer for day-to-day coordination with NIC and Department of Expenditure. The name and contact details of the Nodal Officer may be intimated by 13<sup>th</sup> December 2011 to Department of Expenditure and NIC at email ids [cppp-doe@nic.in](mailto:cppp-doe@nic.in) and [cppp-nic@nic.in](mailto:cppp-nic@nic.in).
  - b. The Nodal Officer may be asked to attend the Workshop to be held in Department of Expenditure on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2011. The workshop will be in two batches one in the forenoon and another in the afternoon. The list of Ministries/ Departments to be covered in each batch will be available on the website of this Department and on the CPP Portal by 15<sup>th</sup> December 2011.
  - c. To enable planning of the training effort and support services, certain information regarding the offices from where tender enquiries are issued such as their location, number of tender enquiries issued and number of officials required to be trained, is required. Information in this regard, relating to the Ministry/ Department and its attached and subordinate offices as per the format at Annexure I may be forwarded at the aforesaid email ids by 15<sup>th</sup> December 2011. Information relating to CPSEs and autonomous/ statutory bodies as per formats at Annexures II and III may be emailed by 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2011.
